Road Gates

Whoever gets to the field first each night, feel free to close the gates. These are not locked and any Parent or Coach involved with Little League can close them at the start of the night/open them back up at the end of the night.

Coach Pitch

Coaches should pitch underhand to their own team. A medium speed ball without too much arc is best. Coaches do not have to pitch from the rubber (may scoot up) and players do not have to swing at bad pitches. In order to keep the game moving, after roughly 5-6 swing and misses, batter should hit off of a tee.

Parent Helpers

Parent helpers are needed on the Farm League field. For example, while the coach is pitching it is nice to have a 1st and 3rd base coach. Also the fielding team should supply a coach/parent helper to stand behind home plate to help keep batters and catchers ready/safe and help throw balls back to pitcher.

Bat Thru the Order

Each team will bat thru the order each inning. After the last batter hits, switch sides. How fast you keep the game moving directly impacts the number of innings played. No scores/standings will be kept for Farm League.

Time Limit

Games have a 1 hour and 20-minute time limit. No inning can start after the time limit is up. For example, for the first game, no inning can start after 6:20pm. Note: the 2nd game does not always start exactly at 6:30pm.

Batting Cages

Home teams get batting cage 4:25-4:40 pm for early games and 5:45-6:05pm for late games. Visiting teams get batting cage 4:40-4:55 pm for early games and 6:05-6:25 pm for late games.

Set Up / Clean Up

Home team for early game is responsible for field set up, such as installing bases. Home team for late game is responsible for putting bases away and installing the base plugs.

Rain Outs

Little League will attempt to notify about postponement of games before 3:30pm, however if the storm is moving in right around game time, this can be difficult. If rained out on Monday, games will be played on Tuesday night at same time and same field. If rained out on Wednesday, game will not be made up due to Senior League which also plays on Thursday nights. Notification will be thru mass txt msg this year.
